Services to support people to get re-housed can be scattered geographically and logistically uncoordinated due in part to funding and staffing challenges. Navigation Centers offer low-barrier services to support our unhoused neighbors.

The proposed Center will offer space to local service providers to more effectively and efficiently serve our unhoused neighbors with a variety of needs. We envision shelter services being offered only during emergency weather events.
